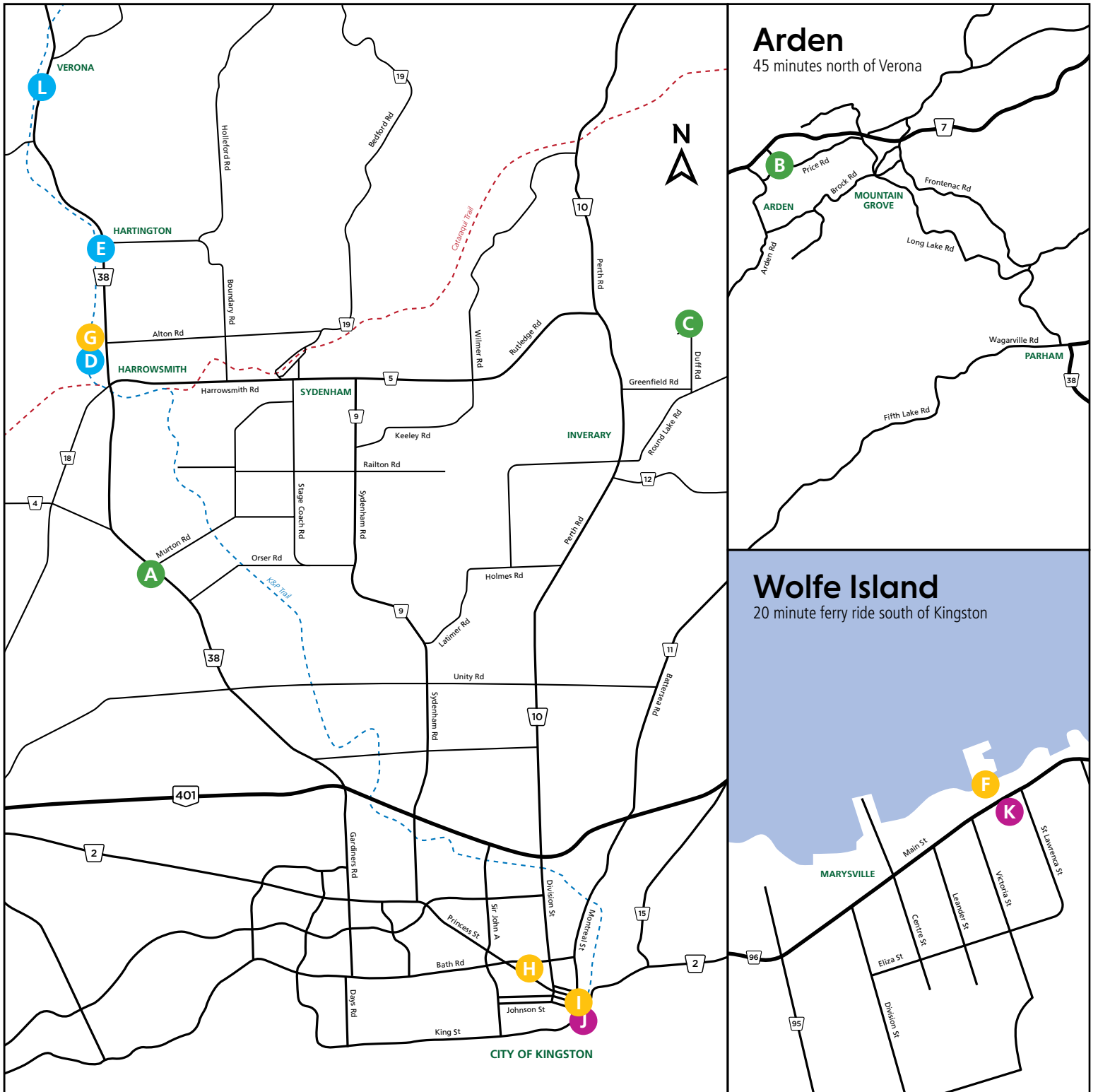

### A Fat Chance Farmstead

3711 Highway 38, Harrowsmith / Sept. 11

Fat Chance Farmstead is a certified organic fruit and vegetable farm that has begun a new partnership growing and milling grains with Grains & Goods Farmstead for selling fresh artisan flour.

- » **Admission Fee:** pay what you can (\$5 or \$20 each, kids free).
- » Learn about the process of harvesting, cleaning, and milling grain.
- » Tour the vegetable and strawberry fields.
- » Learn about the different equipment required to successfully grow high quality organic food.
- » Purchase produce, flour, and baked goods from both Fat Chance Farmstead and Grains & Goods Farmstead.

### B Fireweed Learning Community

1268 Hughes Rd, Arden / Sept. 11 & 12

This tour will be a demonstration of permaculture zones in practice and an explanation of how we are working with the existing property to achieve our homestead goals.

- » A guided tour followed by a Q&A session.
- » Attendees will have the opportunity to browse and potentially purchase canned goods and crafts.

### C Loughborough Heritage Orchard

3371B/C Lakeside Rd, Inverary / Sept. 12

- » U-pick organic apple picking.
- » Self-guided tours along hiking trails past the orchards, along the lake shore, and through the maple sugar bush.
- » The Farm Gate Store will be open where visitors can purchase maple products, apple, fresh eggs, ready picked apples, apple cider mini-donuts, and fresh apple cider made on-site.
- » There will be horses, pigs and chickens on display for visitors to view.
- » A children's play area with a straw maze, corn pool, and playground.
